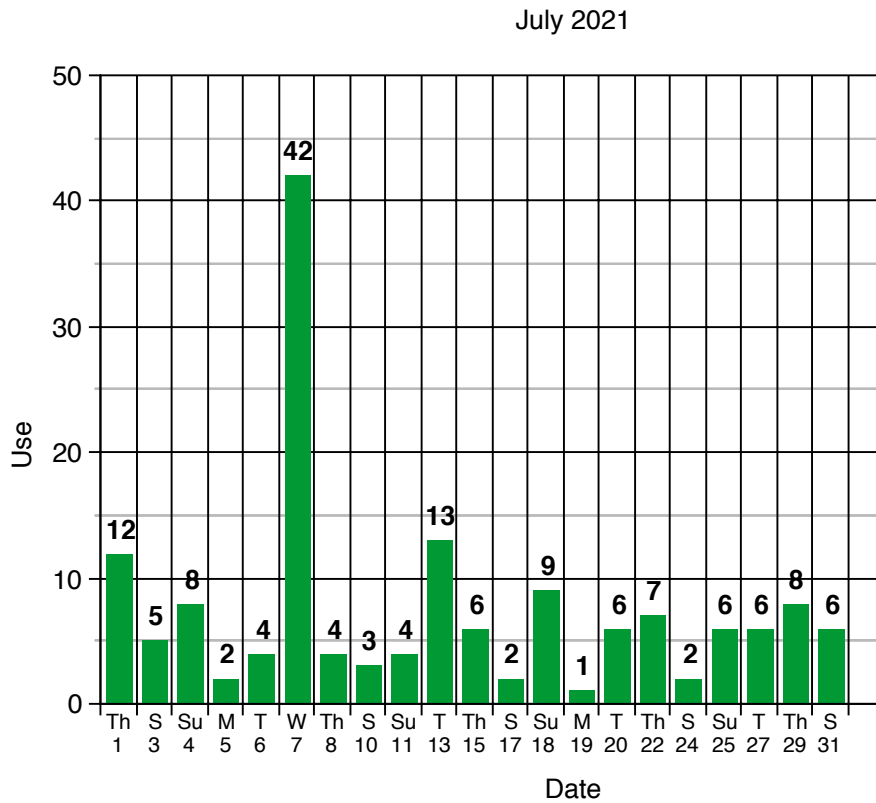
Goals 2021
