Goals 2021

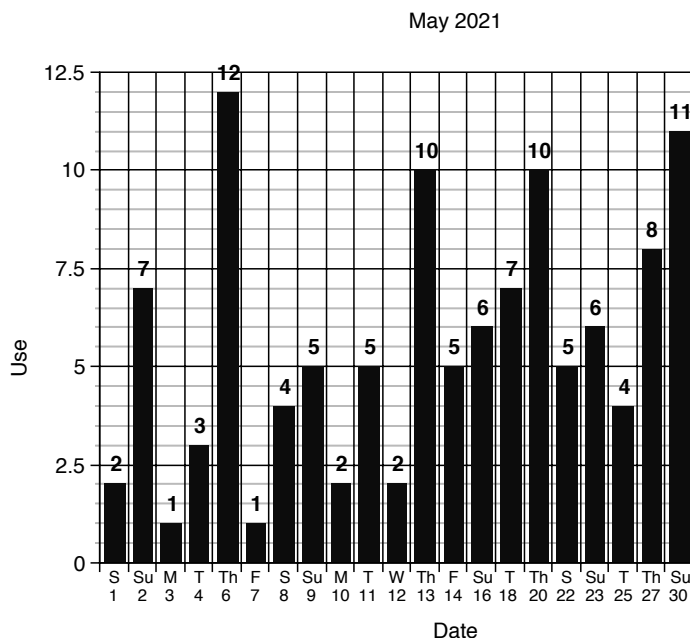
Personnel: to have net gain of 5 over Jan 31 roster
